

NEW YORK, Jan. 20.—Charles Spencer

Chaplin intimated he will be here for perhaps two weeks, in which time he would plan his divorce action. He admitted he was worried, but said he was confident of the outcome. "I have faith in the patience and sense of fair play of the people, until I have a chance in court to tell my side of the




