AGENT GENERAL IN LONDON LAUD-ED AS EFFICIENT OFFICIAL OF B.C. GOVERNMENT

VICTORIA, June 1 .- British Columbia House in London is doing invaluable work for this Province, and F. A. Pauline, agent-general, has proved himself an outstanding figure among the many Empire representatives in London, according to W. B. Ryan, prominent : Victoria businessman, who returned recently from Britain.

After being in close contact with the work of B.C. House during his residence in London, Mr. Ryan has come back to British Columbia delighted with the institution. In an interview he condemned criticism of Mr. Pauline's work as based on ignorance of the facts. People familiar with conditions in England, he said, know that the province is benefiting in a big way !. from the activities of the agent general and his staff.

"It is not generally known in the Provice that British Columbia House in London is operated at a very small cost to the taxpayer. During the present year, after making due provision for all expenditures, including salaries, advertising and the general conduct of the office, the total cost will not exceed \$14,000. This would be after providing for the interest on the mortgage now outstanding against the B.C. House, land rentals, cost of upkeep, etc., and the reason that the expenditures are kept at about this figure is due generally to the satisfactory manner in which the offices are rented and let. "There is a point that I would like to emphasize, and that is the evidence of the change in the feelings of the Britisher towards Canada. Four years ago it was almost impossible to interest any of the people in the British Isles in Canada. Today this feeling is ab-


