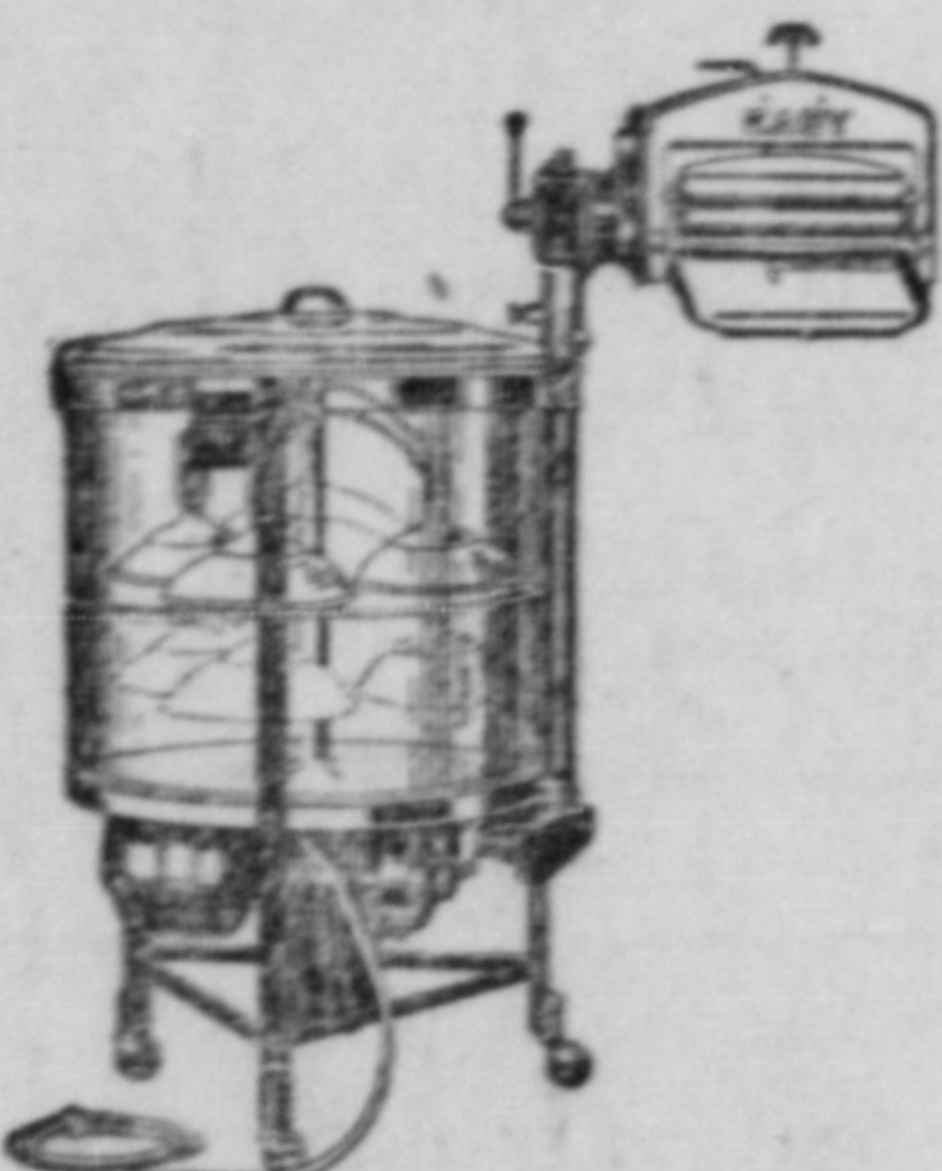

**BEAR ON ROOF
OF HIS CABIN**

Trapper Stood in His Shirt and Killed Big Cinnamon as it Sprang Toward Him

EDMONTON, Sept. 23.—The big cinnamon bear that tried to take the roof from the home, humble though it is, of Charlie Fandrick, the Little Smoky river trapper, may have had lots of gall, but he certainly lacked sense. The result is that he lost both his gall and his life in the ensuing unpleasantness. Arriving one night at one of his outlying cabins in the foothills, the trapper noticed that a moosehide which had been covering the pole roof since last winter had been disturbed. One corner had been chewed off, and an inspection of the ground disclosed the tracks of a big bear.

When the trapper went to his lonely bed that night, he was comforted by the presence of his loaded Winchester beside him. Next morning, long before it was time for any reasonable man to be awake and about, the trapper was disturbed by the noise of some heavy body on the roof. Filled with rage at losing his sleep, Charlie grabbed his rifle and defied death, the conventions and the climate by rushing out in his shirt-tails.

On the roof stood the big bear aforesaid. It snarled with rage and leaped from the roof towards the trapper, as it caught sight of him. In mid-air, the animal was staggered by a heavy slug from the trapper's weapon. As it rolled on the ground, bellowing with rage, the trapper fired again, the bullet shattering one of the bear's hip bones. Despite its broken hind limbs, the bear lurched to its fore feet and dragged itself towards the trapper. It could not move fast, however, and Charlie was given lots of chances to kill it. It died with two bullets through its heart. Its skull is said to be one of the largest of its kind ever taken out of the woods.

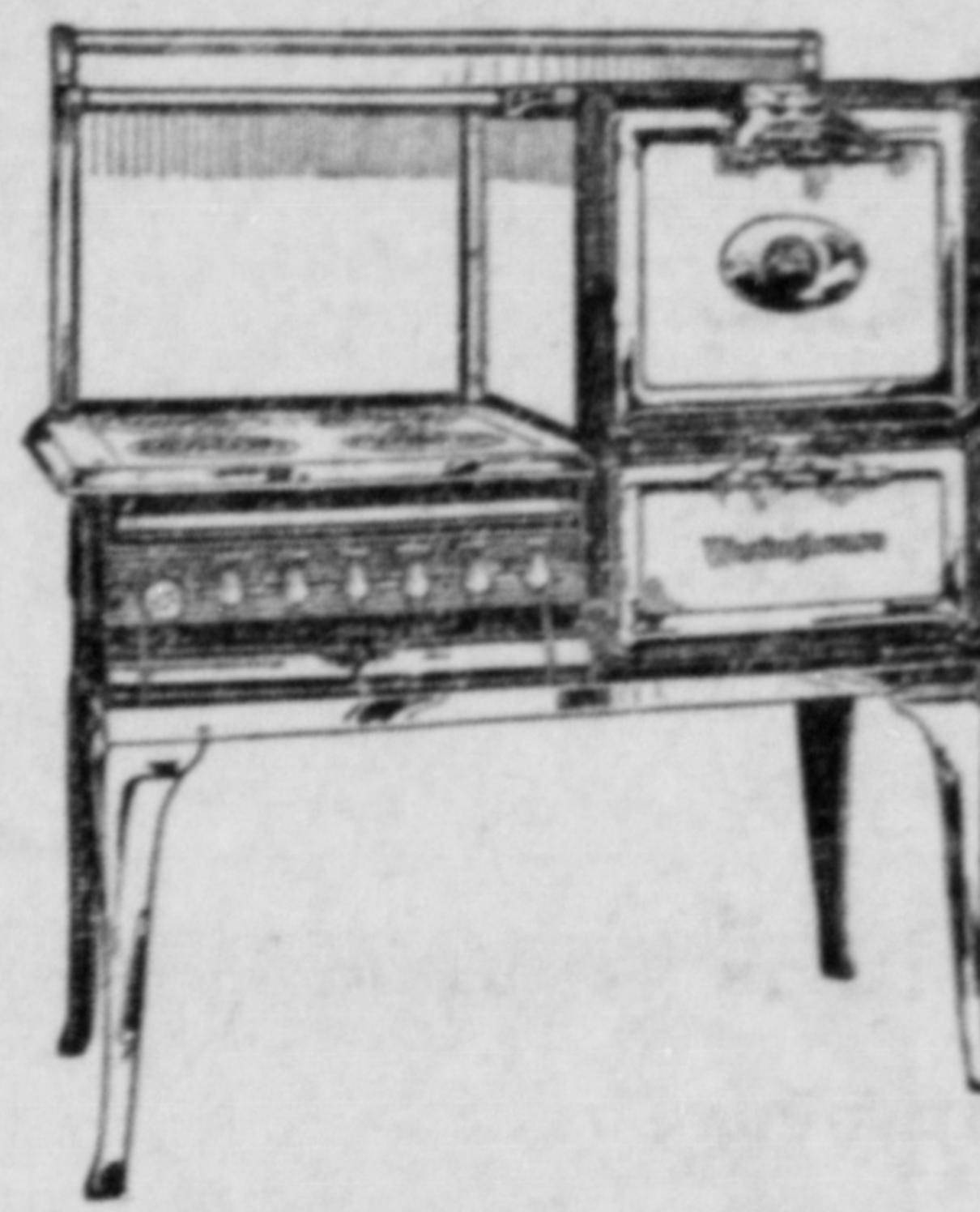
