The two men in the van then attempted to escape, and there was a struggle in the road amid the traffic. The two men were eventually overpowered and taken to the Peckham police

Frank Saunders, the owner of the van, told a Daily News representative that the smartness of the police was not confined to the arrest. They handed the van back to him without delay, and it was driven to the hall in good time for the meal to be served.

RODE TWO HUNDRED WINNERS IN A YEAR FORMERLY STABLE BOY

CHICAGO, Dec. 2. - Lee Hardy, a stable boy two years ago, has helped make turf history by piloting 200 winers past the judges' stand.

The feat of riding 200 winners in a single year has been accomplished only twice before on the American turf in the last 16 years. Guy Garner equalled that mark and Ivan Parke in 1924 rode 205 winners in 844 mounts, for the high record of American riders.

Hardy began riding in the summer of 1926 on Ohio minor tracks, and was signed by Col. Phil Chinn, Kentucky horseman. Last summer, his work so impressed C. E. Durnell, train for W. T. Waggoner, Texas oil millionaire, that Chinn received \$30,000 for the lady's riding contract, almost a record figure.
