

FARMING DISCUSSED

Meeting of Farmer's Institute Was Enthusiastic and Educational

auspices of the Farmers' Institute and presided over by H. L. Frank, the Institute president, one of the most interesting and instructive agricultural meetings ever held here took place on Monday evening in Badminton Hall. Help is given in the way of credit being allowed in the purchase of stock.
