> were recently begun. This is an area where malaria might be expected to arise had not preventive measures been started before the work on the base had commenced. It illustrates the value of prophylactic measures based upon a sound knowledge of the work necessary to effect complete immunity.

Anti-malarial operations there began 1924. Part of the land is hilly, part fresh water swamp, and part mangrove swamp. By drainage, filling, and by the construction of a tidal bund to keep out the sea water, an area of about one square mile has been thoroughly cleared of the breeding places of practically all mosquitoes, including the two dangerous Anopheles umbrosus and Anopheles maculatus.

The majority of the buildings in the naval base have been admirably screened, but recently it has been remarked that even a mosquito net was no longer a necessity, such has been the success of the work carried out upon the most thorough and up-to-date lines.

WALES PADLOCK LAW EFFECTIVE. NIGHT CLUBS ARE WARNED


NEW YORK, April 13 .- Women on the Broadway stage and in night clubs have been warned that they must put on their clothes.
