VIENNA, Feb. 16. -- The capital of Austria which prides itself on being the metropolis of music is preparing fittingly to observe the hundredth anniversary of the death of Beethoven, the celebration lasting over five days, from March 26 to 31. A committee has been formed under the patronage of the president of the State and the arrangements for the commemorative program are well in hand. The Vienna municipality has placed at the disposal of of a committee headed by Professor Guido Adler, the sum of 4,000 schillings, while the Senate has voted 36,-000 schillings on condition that the Bund provide a similar amount.
