

WINNIPEG, Feb. 15 .- Thousands of years ago camels trod the North American continent, when the greater part of it was a desert. Years later an attempt was made to have them supplant the Prairie schooner during the gold rush to California in 1849, and now another attempt is underway to introduce them in Western Canada, as a substitute for the timehonored draft horse, and novel scenes soon may be witnessed on farms in the vicinity of Rosthern, Sask.


