A WOMAN CAME FACE TO FACE WITH GRIZZLY

They Meat She Was Cooking at Big Creature and Rushed for Tree DROWNED IN RIVER

Lure of Gold Draws Party From Tacoma to Far North to Face Disaster

EDMONTON, Sept. 21.—How death and disaster defeated a party from Tacoma, Wash., prospecting in the wild and little-known hinterland of northern British Columbia, was graphically related by the survivors of the ill-fated expedition drawn to the wilderness by the age-old lure of gold. The experiences of the woman of the party were particularly thrilling.

Outfitting in Edmonton last spring, the party, headed by Deckert, with Joe Kinsky, cook, and Mr. and Mrs. Morris Larson, all of Tacoma, detrained at Prince George, 400 miles west, where they took packhorses up through the "No Man's Land" of the little known plateau country north of the railway. The country is inhabited by roving bands of semi-savage Indians and a few prospectors and trappers. It is a series of rolling mountain ranges, interspersed with timbered plateaus. It is said to be rich in fur, game and fish. Here, say the survivors of the stampede of '98 to the Yukon, the next "big strike" will be made.

REPLENISH SUPPLIES

For 21 days they traveled through the wilderness without meeting another soul, finally arriving at Fort Nelson, more than 400 miles north of the railway. This is a Hudson's Bay company's post on the Nelson River, a tributary of the Liard, which, in turn flows into the Mackenzie River. At the fort they replenished some of their supplies and set off again into the last north, determined to explore the country for gold. It was while fording the Half-way river that disaster first overtook the

ill-fated party. Deckert was in front and it is thought that the horse he was riding was none too steady. Below the ford, there was a ledge, where the bed of the river suddenly took a drop of several feet. The horrified riders behind suddenly saw the horse rear up and with a half-human scream plunge under the surface of the rapids.

BODY NEVER RECOVERED

Deckert apparently kicked himself free of the heavy western stirrups, for the others spurring their horses through the water to his aid, saw the horse come up free of its rider, though Deckert himself was never seen again.


