Province Newspaper Replies to President of Prince Rupert Board of Trade

The Vancouver Province takes a whole column of its editorial page to reply to W. O. Fulton, president of the Prince Rupert Board of Trade in regard to a charge that the southern city was reaching sout and trying to get everything. The editorial entitled "Not Really an Ogre" follows:

At a meeting of the Prince Rupert Board of Trade, Friday evening, the question of carving a new province out of Northern British Columbia and Northern Alberta was discussed, and W. O. Fulton, the president, spoke strongly in favor of the plan recently put forward! by Charles Fredericks of Peace River. Vancouver, he complained, was reaching out and trying to get control of everything, no matter whether that control was best for the districts or not. He advocated the creation of a new province to offset, in a measure, the ambitions of Vancouver and, seemingly, he found some support among the members of the board present.

It is unfortunate if the idea has gone abroad in the province that Vancouver is striving to draw all the business of the province to itself, regardless of the hest interests of those districts in which the business originates. It is unfortunate because such an idea must have a disquieting effect. It is unfortunate also, because it is untrue.

OUT FOR BUSINESS

Vancouver, as a commercial city is, of irse, out for business, and it may be there are some among our business men who in their enthusiasm talk Vancouver too much and use methods that might be regarded as over-aggressive. But even these men, if the matter were squarely put up to them, would be among the first to admit the foolishness of attempting to force to this city any business that does not come willingly. It is one of the first axioms of business that both parties to a transaction must be satisfied. Otherwise the transaction will not be repeated; and it is in repeated transactions that business profit lies.

Vancouver, of course, as Canada's principal gateway on the Pacific, could develop and grow even if it did no business with the country immediately surrounding it. But its people realize that it can have a more ordered and substantial development if it does business with the country round about. Doing business, however-especially doing the best and most probitable business-does not at all mean bleeding the country white. It means rather developing the country and encouraging its i orening up and settlement. From a purely selfish point of view, it would be the depth of folly on Vancouver's part to force any industry or traffic into Vancouver which could, more economically, go to some other part of the province. The creation of a city like Prince Rupert or Nelson or Trail means almost as much in the way of business to Vancouver as would the addition of the same number of people to our own population.

COMING FAST ENOUGH

That is one reason why Vancouver has no designs on the business which the smaller cities of the province might claim as legitimately theirs. Another is that without any artificial stimulus Vancouver is growing quite as rapidly as is good for her. If the people came to us in larger numbers than are coming, it would try our capacity to take care of them. It would aggravate our traffic problems, upset our town-planning schemes, and throw undue expense upon us in the way of providing facilities before we are ready to provide
