CURIOUS CEREMONY AT GREEK ORTHODOX SERVICE IN MON-TREAL

OTTAWA, June 14 .- With all kinds of ceremonies, strange to Canadians but part of the usual ritual of the Greek Orthodox Evangelisimos Church of Montreal, little John Tragiskos of this city was baptized by a Montreal priest in a large galvanized wash-tub never before used, and afterwards destroyed. The water from the tub must always be either emptied into a stream or into a hole in the ground. After it was partly filled with water holy oil was poured in. From the tub the child was placed in a sheet held in the godfather's arms. Then the priest clipped the child's hair and threw the locks into the tub, after which the child was removed to another room to be dressed, then given the holy sacrament by the priest.
