BOY BAPTIZED IN A NEW TUB
CURIOUS CEREMONY AT GREEK ORTHODOX SERVICE IN MONTREAL

OTTAWA, June 14.—With all kinds of ceremonies, strange to Canadians but part of the usual ritual of the Greek Orthodox Evangelismos Church of Montreal, little John Tragiskos of this city was baptized by a Montreal priest in a large galvanized wash-tub never before used, and afterwards destroyed. The water from the tub must always be either emptied into a stream or into a hole in the ground. After it was partly filled with water holy oil was poured in. From the tub the child was placed in a sheet held in the godfather's arms. Then the priest clipped the child's hair and threw the locks into the tub, after which the child was removed to another room to be dressed, then given the holy sacrament by the priest. During the actual ceremony the child was in charge of his godmother until the final word of the ritual had been pronounced. Until the baptism is finished the child is not considered free from sin and must not be handled by the parents during the rites.

The godfather was Jimmy Atsalinos of this city and the godmother Miss Florence Pilon, sister of Mrs. Fragiskos. The ceremony of giving the baby his Greek name Ioannis (John) took place in the parlor in the presence only of those directly connected with the christening. It is an ancient custom for a gift to be made to the first person to notify the parents of the name under which the baby has been christened. It is also a custom for the godfather to present a gift to all those present and in this case Mr. Atsalinos presented the mother with a handsome sum of money and a gift of the same nature to all those present, including children. A dinner and musical program followed.
