

MISS MAZO DE LA ROCHE WROTE BEST NOVEL FOR ATLANTIC MAGAZINE

CLARKSON, Ont., April 27.(-Canadian Press).-This pretty village on the Toronto-Hamilton Highway was all agog over the announcement that Miss Mazo de la Roche of Toronto, who lives here in her own home during the summer, has won the \$10,000 prize offered by the Atlantic Magazine for the best novel. There were 1,200 competitors. Her novel "Jalna" is a story of an English family. three generations of it, and their life on a huge estate in the Canadian woods. It was begun in May, 1925, and finished last December. The \$10,000 prize is over and above royalties and serial rights, which makes the award one of the most notable ever won by a Canadian.

Her great ambition, in her own words, is "to write a fine Canadian play and have a good asparagus bed," Her garden about the cottage in the birch-woods is always levely with flowers, but not a wild thing of beauty may be destroyed



Peace River outlet, according to J. Brady, M.P. for Skeena, who returned to the city yesterday from Ottawa. Mr. Brady's opinion, the report of engineers which has been submitted on the question was untenable and unsupportable as the development of that country, he said, was an absolute; necessity to Canada.

### MR. BENNETT WAXES SARCASTIC IN VOTE FOR ELEVATOR SITE

Hon. R. B. Bennett, Conservative member for Calgary, waxed sarcastic when the vote of \$165,000 for the Prince Rupert elevator site was being considered in the House of Commons. Debate on the matter was as follows:

Mr. Gardiner: Is this to pay for the site on which the elevator now stands? Mr. Malcolm (minister of trade and commerce): Yes, it is a revote. The amount is payable from the Dominion government to the Grand Trunk Pacific Railway, now the Canadian National

Mr. Bennett: This is the property which is leased for \$100 per year, including the site?

Mr. Malcolm: Yes.

Mr. Bennett: And the elevator is built upon railway property. Now it is being turned over to the elevator company, and the \$165,000 is a kook-keep-

Mr. Malcolm: Surely.

Mr. Bennett: And the rental is \$100? Mr. Malcolm: Yes, it is rented to the pool for \$100.


