ACTIVITY IN FLOUR MARKET

ADVANCE AS LIKELY TO BE MAINTAINED—POTATOES ARE WEAK—NEW GREEN STUFFS ARRIVING

Flour is the centre of activity today on both retail and wholesale markets. Due to unfavorable weather and late spring conditions do not look good. The market has advanced forty cents per barrel during the past week and there is little doubt but that the advance will be maintained and possibly prices may go much higher.

With ample supplies of Terrace and up-country stock, the local potato market is dull. The low price of new spuds is seriously retarding sales. Growers in the Terrace vicinity with few exceptions platted their crops last fall with the result that the market had to seek supplies from Smithers and points east. Terrace shippers are badly disappointed this spring to find prices lower than they were offered in the fall. Many are going to feed them to the hogs rather than ship them at present low prices.

In the realm of green stuffs, cucumbers of the white spine variety are plentiful and size is good at 25c each. British Columbia hot house tomatoes are now arriving but the price is high at 55c per pound. Mexican tomatoes at 35c per pound are meeting with

popular demand. The color and stock is better than usual. Rhubarb is getting more plentiful, the outdoor variety having displaced the hothouse product. With a gradual stiffening in apple prices, the demand for rhubarb is increasing steadily.

Genuine imported Bermuda onions are again on the market at two pounds for 35c. These should not be confused with a similar onion grown in Oregon which retails for half this price but falls far short of the quality of the genuine Bermuda onion.

Australian grapes, packed in sawdust, have just arrived. These are of the green color variety and the quality is choice, the price being 40c per pound.

Strawberries are arriving on southern markets but they are not yet fit to ship this far. What few crates have arrived so far have caused grief to the shippers.
