WHITE SLAVERY

WHOLESALE TRAFFIC IN NARCOTICS IS ALSO REVEALED BY LEAGUE OF NATIONS

March 10. - World-wide smuggling in drugs and the increase in the white slave traffic, both of which have reached alarming proportions, are being discussed at the meeting of the League of Nations, now in session at

A sensational report on the immense illicit trade in narcotic drugs has been published by the league, while documentary evidence concerning the white slave traffic is expected to be revealed a few days.

The report on drugs mentions transactions involving more than 65 tons of raw opium, 220 pounds of heroin, 638 pounds of morphine and 39 pounds of cocaine. In this connection an inquiry is still proceeding, which has revealed a diversion of 1,650 pounds of drugs through one channel alone.




