

FINE HARBORS

Will Provide Route for Both Canadian and American Grain is Ambitious Prediction

Judson Straits is fraught with far less danger to navigation than Lawrence river from Montreal to the sea, said Capt. Bartlett, famous Arctic explorer, in an interview with a newspaper correspondent here.

Captain Bartlett, who was a member of Peary's North Pole expedition, envisages a time when the grain not only of Canada's prairie provinces, but that of the northwestern United States, will go to European countries by the northern outlet, with a great assembly point in Saskatchewan or Manitoba, probably at Saskatoon or The Pas.
