Labor Delegation at Victoria Asks for Control by Department and Less Home Work

VICTORIA, Sept. 18 .- Control of text book prices by the Department of Education, greater standardization of the books, and possible distribution of the books by the school authorities themselves, were points urged on the City School Board by a delegation from the Trades and Labor Coun-

The delegation asked support for the suggestion that text books be purchased wholesale by the educational authorities and dis tributed at the actual cost of handling; that fewer changes be made in the text of the books from time to time, so that new books would not become obsolete and useless within a single season; that homework be reduced or eliminated wherever possible; and that school boundaries as set be rigidly adhered to in the placing of students.

Speaking about homework, the delegation thought six hours in school and two hours homework too long in one day for a student, in the interests of health. Either all the work should be done at school, or else the homework portions should be lightened considerably, they suggested.


