Both steps have been hailed in certain quarters as signs of Turkey's advance. But let us look deeper.

It can be argued that the preservation in Turkey of Islam, even of an Islam shorn of the accretion which had grown round it in the centuries of orthodox Arabic influence, was inconsistent with the progressive laicisation of Law and Justice, and that disestablishment was, therefore, inevitable. On the other hand, it can be argued that this final act of disestablishment is proof that the Muscovite leaven has at last worked in Turkey and that although the economic theories of Bolshevism are inapplicable to Anatolia, the "spiritual" impulse of the leaders of this revolution are the leaders of the Russian Revolution has at last communicated itself to their Turkish comrades. 


