"It is many years since the city was so deeply moved as it was when news of the drowning of Thor Johnson and E. C. Gibbons at Hartley Bay was given out. Gibbons-good-humored, optimistic and friendly- and in and out of season a strong booster for the north, can ill be spared. Johnson was another excellent type of citizen, but more retiring."

The Interior News, knowing only one of them says:

"Should it prove-as each hour helps to establish the regrettable fact—that E. C. Gibbons of Prince Rupert has lost his life in the coast waters near Hartley Bay, then the personal and public loss will extend much beyond the incorporated limits of his own home city, in which he has pioneered from the first. That blow will reverberate throughout the interior, where Mr. Gibbons had hundreds of freinds, some made in the early days, others developed from time to time by his personal magnetism and strengthened by his! frankness and depth of god fellowship, "Gib" was a regular! summer visitor to our town and our valley; he will be greatly missed at our annual celebrations he helped to make so lively. Truly, the first big shock must, be felt in his own city, but "Gib" had demonstrated an interest and cultivated friendships that transcended all localisms, and his tragic end will cause deep regret throughout that long thin line of men and wamen extending across the country who once called Rupert their home."
