THE RED MARK AT WESTHOLME

Dramatic Love Romance With Plenty of Thrills in This Feature Picture

New in locale, dramatic, impressive, with a tensely appealing love romance, "The Red Mark," featuring a quartet of brilliant screen players, at the Westholme tonight and tomorrow, is one of the most remarkable offerings to the picture showmen of the current picture season. TOM MIX RUNS TRUE TO FORM

Plays Role of Tom Dane in "The Last Trail" and Rescues Girl From Indians

Tom Mix, playing the role of Tom Dane, in his latest Fox Films drama, a version of Zane Grey's famous western novel, "The Last Trail," in the big double-feature program at the Westholme tonight and tomorrow, rescues a white girl from the camp of the Sioux Indians, on the warpath in their last efforts to drive the white men from the buffalo hunting grounds of the Dakotas.

Mounted on Tony, his sure-footed horse, Mix, followed by Lee Shumway, playing an army scout, dashes into the camp, gets the girl and races away. The race and the fight continues to the gates of the stockade, where soldiers see the dash of the gallant horsemen, open the gates and turn their rifles loose. The girl becomes the wife of Joe Pascal, the scout, who moves to an Arizona mining camp and becomes a sheriff as soon as the Indians have been subdued and peace restored to the Dakota hills. 'BENHUR' IS UNEQUALLED IN PHOTO HISTORY

Has Cast of 150,000 People. Chariot Race Staged on Huge Scale. Fleet of 100 Ancient Vessels in Big Sea Fight Between Romans and Pirates.

HISTORIC ACHIEVEMENT

General Lew Wallace's "Ben-Hur: A Tale of the Christ," that was a stage spectacle twenty-two years, and as a book enjoyed a circulation as large as the Bible, will be seen Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday at the Capitol. It comes here after long runs and crowded houses in the larger cities throughout the continent.

Fred Niblo directed the production which begins with the Wise Men and the Star of Bethlehem, pictures Jerusalem under the Roman tyranny and the condemnation of the Prince of Hur to the galleys. The battle twixt the Roman fleet and the Greek pirates was filmed with a great Ben-Hur navy of antique modeled craft off the coast of Italy.

Thrills and Romance

The celebrated Antioch chariot race, in which Ben-Hur and Messala contest for the palm, occupied three months in the making. Twelve quadrigas are driven seven laps over a course facing a Circus Maximus that holds nearly a hundred thousand spectators. The exquisite love story of Ben-Hur and Esther is intertwined with the thrilling action.

The final scenes deal with Ben-Hur's assembling of legions in the plan to establish a kingdom of Judea, the discovery of his long lost mother and sister in the Vale of Hinnom, the procession of Palm Sunday, and the healing of the sick ones by the Saviour, whereby Ben-Hur and his beloved Esther and kinsfolk are reunited.

A World Epic

In a grandiose epic that has taken three years for its completion and included as many real-life adventures as an historic odyssey of the Old and New Worlds' Ramon Novarro (in the title role), Betty Bronson, May McAvoy, Francis X. Bushman and Carmel Myers have prominent parts. The music for the production was written by David Mendoza and William Axt, the composers of "The Big Parade."
