"It wasn't easy," replied Mr. Muzzy modestly. He wondered what the play was.

"Such foresight," continued Miss Brash. "Looks like you knew just how Mr. Champion was going to play the hand . . . and then blocked him."

Mr. Muzzy still didn't know what she was talking about. Making a blind stab, he said, "Well, I thought he was going to try to squeeze me, so I . . ."

"How could there be a squeeze?" broke in Mr. Champion angrily. "I didn't have any semblance of an entry to dummy. You just pulled the wrong card again and as usual it turned out to be the right play."

Here is what happened. Mr. Muzzy led the ace and another spade. Miss Brash won the second trick with the king and led back a third spade. After some thought, Mr. Champion ruffed with the queen of hearts.

Mr. Muzzy, who wasn't expecting this and who wasn't paying attention, played the jack of hearts—a sure winner later, if he had discarded a diamond at trick three.

This was the killing defensive play, however, as it left Mr. Champion with no possible way of getting out of his hand and later he had to lose two clubs for down one.

Look at the beautiful play available to Mr. Champion if Mr. Muzzy had retained his three hearts to the jack. After winning the third trick with the queen of hearts, he could have cashed the ace of diamonds and then thrown Mr. Muzzy in with

the third round of hearts. At this point Mr. Muzzy would have had nothing left but diamonds and a diamond return would have put dummy in to cash the king and queen of that suit. On these cards Mr. Champion could have discarded both of his losing clubs.

"Defense is the most important part of the game," remarked Mr. Muzzy importantly.

Mr. Champion snorted. "The only thing you're proved," he said, "is that you play better asleep than awake."
