IT TOOK INDIANS THOUSAND YEARS TO MINE TWO TONS

Broken Rock Hammered by Natives Until Metal Was Extracted After Heating.

MILWAUKEE, Wis., Oct. 19.—Archaeologists with two expeditions of the Milwaukee public museum this summer digging into Wisconsin mounds and pounding their way through the rocky soil of Isle Royale, Mich., have added pages to the scientific history of the American Indian of centuries before Columbus.

The Isle Royale expedition revealed the tedious work of copper mining among Indians who spent several months each year on that rugged island far out in Lake Superior.

In no fewer than 1,000 years the Indians, working many times that number of mines, took out two tons of copper, says George A. West, Milwaukee attorney and president of the museum, who headed the expedition.

These ancients would heat the copper-bearing stone until it was dry and brittle, pour water on it until it cracked and then hammer at the fragments. Scattered over the island are piles of broken hammers which were used for the purpose.
