

WAS FORMERLY U.S. NAVY HEAD

Edwin Denby, ex-Secretary of Navy, is Enroute to Khutze Inlet Mine

A noted visitor to British Columbia is Edwin Denby, former secretary of the Navy for the United States under the Harding administration, who is arriving on this coast by airplane to visit Khutze Inlet where he will inspect mining property of the Revenue Mining Co. in which he is heavily interested. By profession, Mr. Denby is a Detroit lawyer, but he spent much of his life in the navy. As a youth he went to China, his father having been United States minister in that country, and he himself spent several years in the Chinese Imperial Maritime Customs Service. He was admitted to the bar in 1896 and two years later enlisted in the Spanish American War, serving as gunner's mate on U.S.S. Yosemite. He later became a sergeant in the United States Marine Corps and in 1919 went on reserve as a major. Returning to Detroit, he entered political life and served both in the House of Representatives and Congress before he was called to the Harding administration.

Interested in the mine with Secretary Denby is Major Harragh, commander in chief of the American Legion, and Charles Cole, both of whom are arriving here this afternoon and go south to Khutze Inlet on the Cardena. Secretary Denby and the rest of the party were to come but changed their plans and decided to fly to B.C. instead.

Gaylor W. Norton and C. J. Lieber, also Detroit directors of the Revenue Mining Co., arrived here this week from Los Angeles and will go south as well tomorrow morning.
