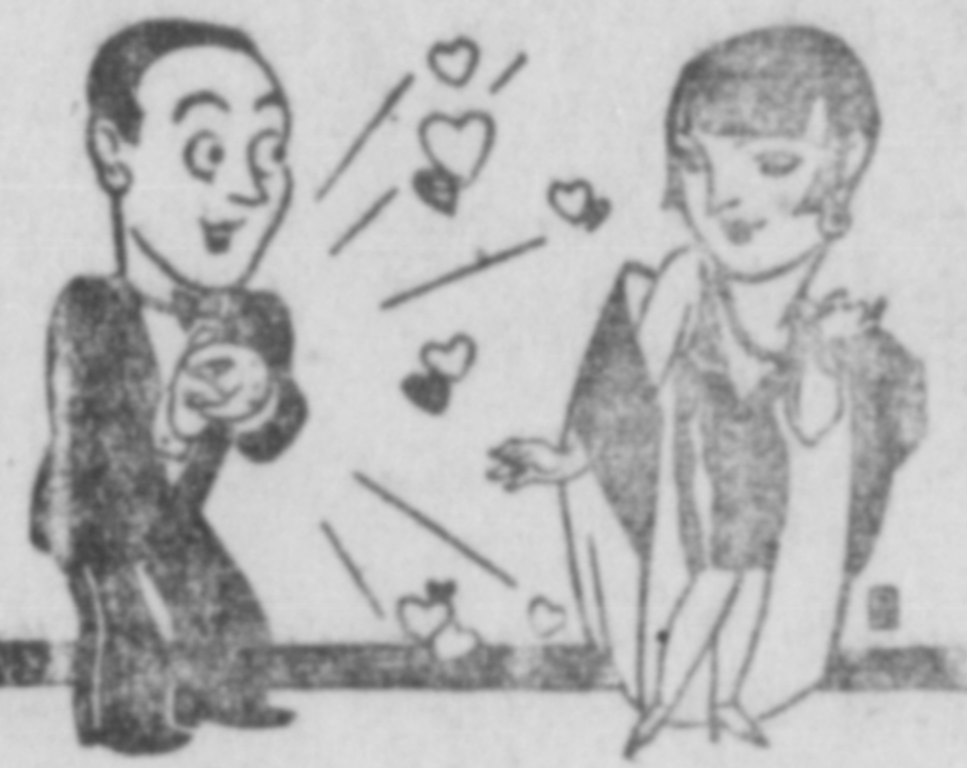

EMISSARY OF FRENCH SCOUTS

Paul Coze Gives Brief Address to Rotary Club at Luncheon Yesterday

Paul Coze "Commissaire des Scouts de France," gave a brief address at the Rotary Club luncheon yesterday. He was the guest there of the president, George Rorie, who is head of the scout movement in this city.

Mr. Coze explained that he had come to Canada to bring a flag and decorations from France for the head of the Scouts in Ottawa. It was a good will visit. He also was making a study of the natives of this country.

In France, Mr. Coze said, there were 30,000 scouts. Last year the number was 20,000. They were similar in every way to the Baden-Powell scouts of England and Canada. The movement was making great headway in France.

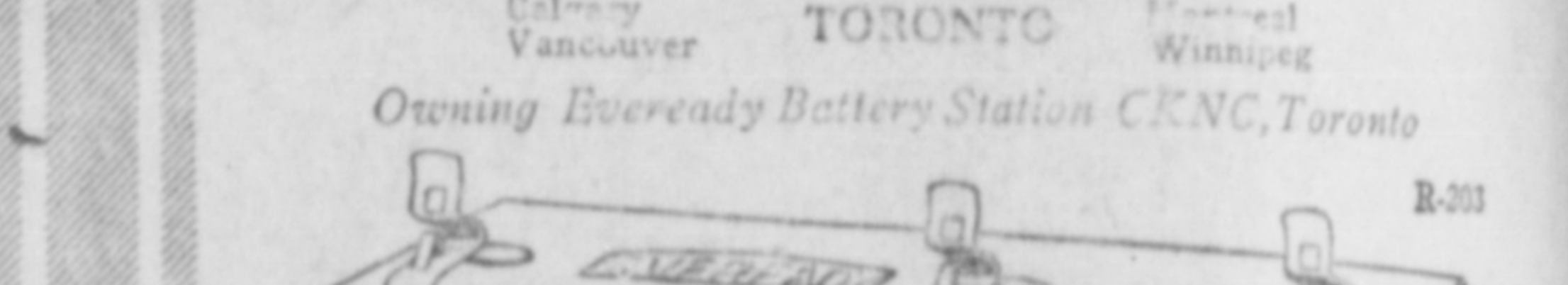
