## MANY AFTER EDMONTON'S POWER SYSTEM

EDMONTON, May 22.—With three definite propositions already before council and at least two more in prospect, offers for Edmonton's electric light and power system are coming in thick and fast. Both Mayor Bury and City Commissioner Mitchell expect several additional bids before many more weeks have elapsed.

The latest indication of an offer reached here when the city commissioners were advised that the Dominion Electric Power company, of Watrous, Sask., is desirous of submitting a proposal.

"While our engineers will not be available to make an examination of the power situation in Edmonton until about June 1," writes F. D. Reid, assistant treasurer of the company, "we would then be able to make a careful survey and submit a definite proposal, which we believe would be very attractive to the city."

"We wish to ask for an opportunity to present such a proposal before your city takes any final action in regard to the propositions now before it."

As things now stand, therefore, two offers from the Calgary Power company and one from Mid-West Utilities Ltd. are in the hands of council. Mayor Bury has been advised that a bid is forthcoming from an American corporation; the Dominion Electric Power company is to submit a proposal, and still others may enter the field at a later date.
