## IMPERIAL CONFERENCE MEETING NOT LIKELY UNTIL POSSIBLY 1930

LONDON, July 21.—The Daily News says—A combination of circumstances will prevent the Imperial Conference—which should have taken place next year—from meeting until 1930 at the earliest.

The General Election in this country and the elections in Australia and in South Africa will be mainly responsible for the delay.

When the Conference meets again in London, therefore, it is possible that a different party may be in power, the newspaper says.

## HEN-PECKED HUSBANDS ARE JOYOUS CREATURES

LONDON, July 21.—His investigations among a group of hen-pecked husbands were the theme of an address by Dr. C. W. Kimmins, formerly chief inspector of education for the London County Council, to a women's conference at Leeds.

"I never knew such a group of happy, joyous creatures in my life," declared Dr. Kimmins. "I was glad to learn afterwards that hen-pecked husbands live much longer than those who are not hen-pecked, because they live much more sheltered lives. The great majority of them are not hen-pecked, but hen-protected."

## KODIAK BEARS WORRY STOCK WESTERN ALASKA

SEWARD, Alaska, July 21.—Seventeen head of cattle belonging to White and Wingfield stock range on Kitzhuyak Bay, 30 miles northeast of Kodiak, have been killed by brown bear during the past month. The law protects these bears which is making it difficult for stockmen to attempt to graze cattle, sheep and hogs on Kodiak and Afognak Islands.

## DAME ELLEN TERRY DEAD

FAMOUS ENGLISH ACTRESS SUCCEEDED THIS MORNING AT AGE OF OVER 80 YEARS

LONDON, July 21.—Dame Ellen Terry, famous English actress, died this morning at Smallditch, Kent. She was just past eighty years of age. Her funeral will take place on Tuesday.

Sarah Bernhardt called Ellen Terry "the greatest actress in the world." Her artistic partnership over a period of twenty-four years, with Sir Henry Irving constituted one of the most brilliant periods of the English stage.

She was almost as well known in the United States where she was presented by Charles Frohman as in her native Britain, having toured it ten times and considering it her second home. In her tours of America she was greeted as a queen and a monster jubilee in 1906 was celebrated in honor of the half-century of her connection with the stage. She was married three times.

She was personally acquainted with many of the great personages of the Victorian era, including Disraeli, Gladstone and Tennyson.

Autograph Hunters pursued her everywhere and she finally capitalized the situation for the sake of charity by charging a shilling for each autograph and turning the money into maintenance of a cot in a children's hospital.

Queen Victoria witnessed Miss Terry's stage debut at the age of eight and thought so much of her histrionic ability "that years later she "commanded" her presence at Sandringham Palace where she performed for the Queen and the future King Edward VII.

King George V created Miss Terry a Dame Grand Cross of the British Empire in 1925. St. Andrew's University honored her with the degree of Doctor of Laws.

SHAKESPEARIAN ROLES Miss Terry's outstanding roles were those of Portia and Ophelia although she made remarkable portrayals of Juliet, Beatrice, Desdemona, Margaret, Lady Macbeth, Rosamund, Guinevere, Imogen, Olivia and Madam Sans-Gene. Her great triumph came in 1875 as Portia under the management of the Bancrofts and her fame was firmly founded three years later when she played Ophelia to the Hamlet of Sir Henry Irving.

Her last stage appearance was in the aid of charity when on January 18, 1923 she spoke the prologue to "The York Nativity Play" at the League of Arts Guildhouse, London. After that she virtually retired to her home at Bureleigh Mansions, London, where she spent the declining years of her life surrounded by her friends and loved ones and basking in the glory of her dramatic honors.

Miss Terry was born February 27, 1848 at Coventry in Warwickshire, almost in the heart of the Shakespeare country she was destined to represent so well.
