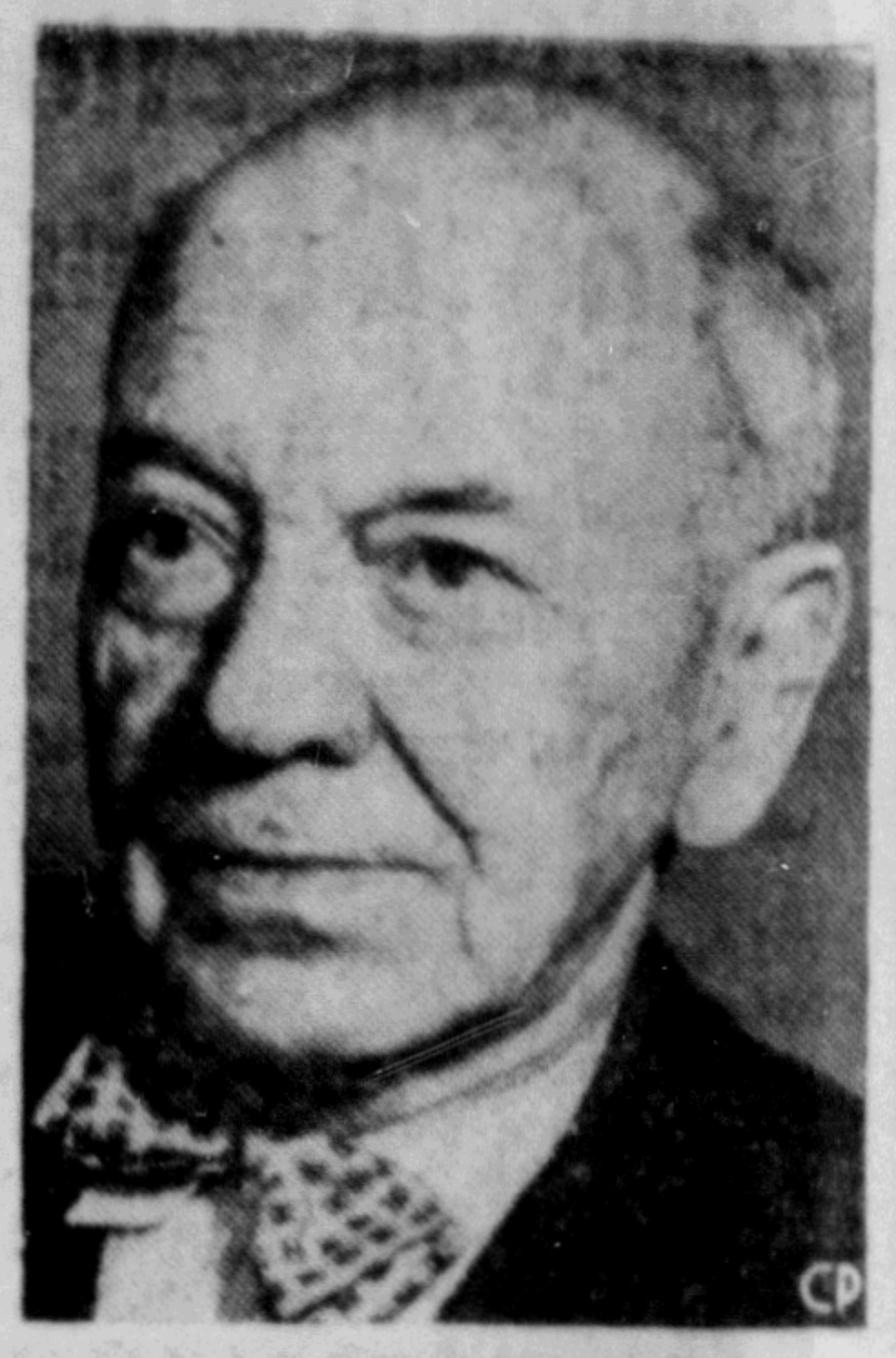

Usual Reasoning Doesn't Govern Miss Brash's Play

It wasn't the opening lead but the second lead made by Miss Brash which guaranteed the downfall of this contract.

The opening was the six of hearts and Mr. Masters put up the queen. Mrs. Keen let this hold on the chance that Miss Brash had started with six cards in the suit. Mr. Masters returned a heart and the jack lost to Miss Brash's ace.

At this point it was clear to Miss Brash that another heart lead would set up the balance of her suit. But what purpose would that serve? The closest thing she had to an entry was the jack of diamonds.

She decided that if the contract could be set at all, it would have to be 'Mr. Masters's' cards that would do the job. What to lead, then, at the third trick?

From the looks of dummy's clubs it appeared that a club lead would only help Mrs. Keen. As to diamonds, Mrs. Keen had bid that suit and there was a supporting honor on the board.

That left only the spade suit. If Mrs. Keen had two of the top spade honors it was unlikely that the contract could be defeated. In any case a spade looked like the best shot.

So out came the 10 of spades. The jack went on from dummy. Mr. Masters played the queen and was permitted to win. He returned a low spade and again Mrs. Keen ducked. She won the spade continuation and now spade stopper.

Burnaby To Get Oil Pipe Line

VANCOUVER (CP)—Construction of a \$1,000,000 oil pipeline system in Burnaby will get under way in the spring, Canadian Bechtel Ltd., agent for Trans Mountain Oil Pipe Line Company, said today.

Missouri Valley Canadian Ltd. of Winnipeg has been awarded the contract to build three crude oil pipelines in the municipality to supply oil refineries and the loading dock. The lines will start from the tank farm at the terminus of the line from Edmonton.
