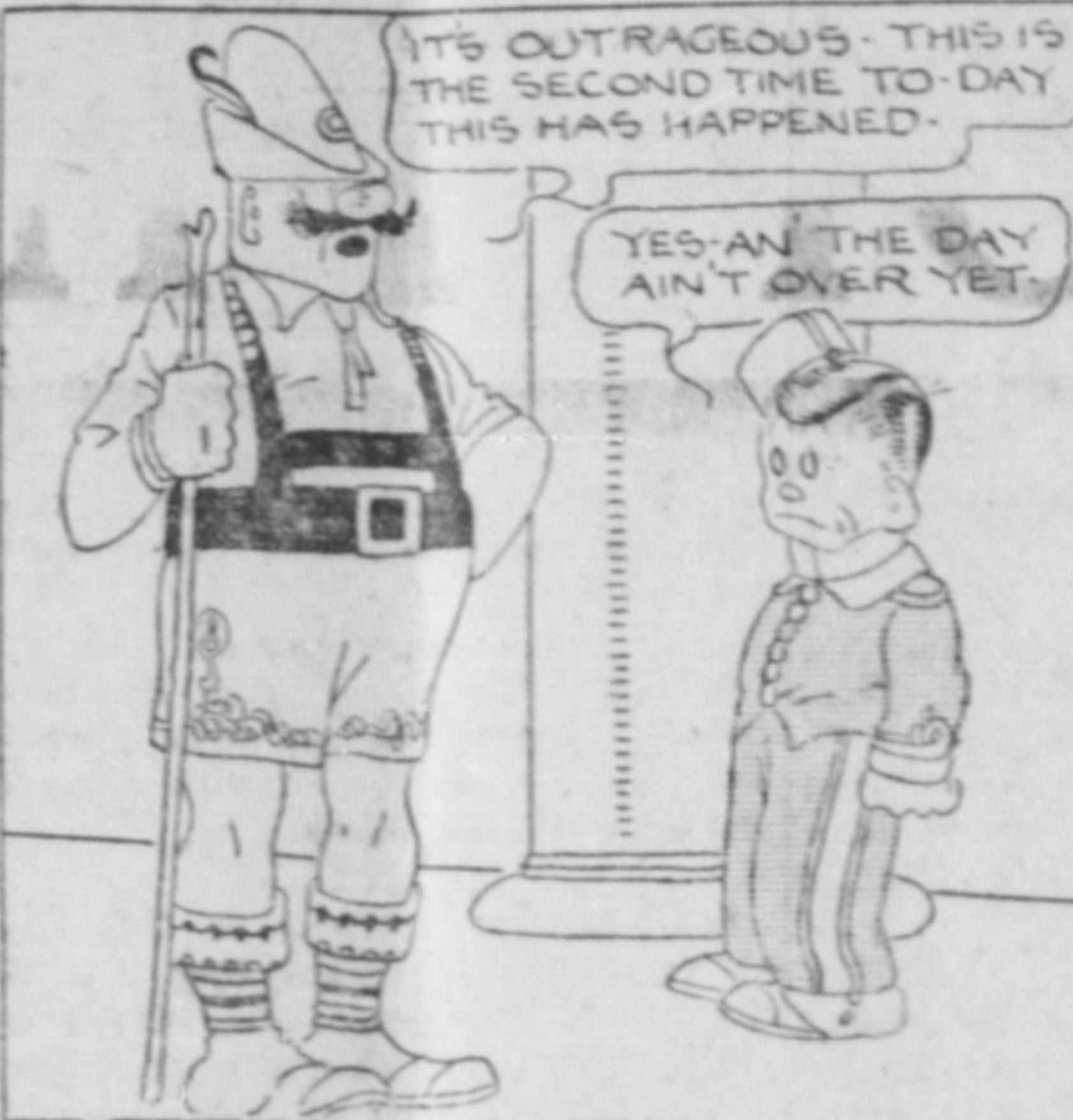

LARGE CONCOURSE ATTENDED OBSEQUIES IN ANGLICAN CATHEDRAL AND FOLLOWED CORTEGE TO CEMETERY

One of the largest concourses of mourners that has attended a funeral here in many a day was present at St. Andrew's Anglican Cathedral at 4 o'clock yesterday afternoon to pay last respects to the memory of Mr. Marjorie Leek, esteemed pioneer woman of this city.

The obsequies took place under the auspices of the Ladies' Orange Benevolent Association and the Pythian Sisters in both of which organizations deceased had been an active member for many years.

SYNOPSIS OF LAND ACT AMENDMENTS

PRE-EMPTIONS Vacant, unreserved, surveyed Crown lands may be pre-empted by British subjects over 18 years of age, and by aliens on declaring intention to become British subjects, conditional upon residence, occupation, and improvement for agricultural purposes.

Full information concerning regulations regarding pre-emption is given in Bulletin No. 1, Land Series, "How to Pre-empt Land," copies of which can be obtained free of charge by addressing the Department of Lands, Victoria, B.C., or to any Government Agent.

Records will be granted covering only land suitable for agricultural purposes, and which is not timberland, i.e., carrying over 8,000 board feet per acre west of the Coast Range and 1,000 feet per acre east of that Range.

Applications for pre-emption are to be addressed to the Land Commissioner of the Land Recording Division in which the land applied for is situated, and are made on printed forms, copies of which can be obtained from the Land Commissioner.

PURCHASE Applications are received for purchase of vacant and unreserved Crown lands, not being timberland, for agricultural purposes, minimum price for first-class (arable) land is \$5 per acre, and second-class (grazing) land \$2.50 per acre.
