PROSPECTOR IS VISITING CITY

GEORGE BUNN, OWNER OF ENGINEER GROUP ON MARMOT RIVER HERE YESTERDAY

One of the old timers of the north country, George Bunn of Stewart, arrived in the city from the south yesterday on his way back to the mines from Vancouver. He is the owner of the Engineer group of mineral claims on the South Fork of the Marmot River adjoining Marmot Metals about six miles back from tidewater. It is on a good horse trail and the wagon road will be constructed to within 2,000 feet of it this summer, thus enabling easy access to be obtained.

While Mr. Bunn works alone on the claim, driving into the mountain, he has already done considerable development work and the ore he has taken out goes 25.8 per cent of copper and 31 ounces of silver. There are some good showings and he is now planning to secure capital for further development. Like all prospectors he carries around a pocketful of nice looking rock. He mentions that there is a stream close by his property suitable for power development and mining timber in abundance.

Mr. Bunn did placer mining in the Yukon in the early days and has also prospected in Alaska.

RECORD MONTH AT LIBRARY

DURING MARCH THERE WERE 4,387 BOOKS LOANED OF WHICH 902 WERE JUVENILE

March was a record month at the public library, according to the report of the librarian, Miss Cruikshank, who said the number of books put out was 75 ahead of last March which was the highest up to that time. The total number loaned in the 22 days the library was open was 4,387 or an average of 219.9 a day. The books were classified as non-fiction 481, juvenile 902 and those known as the duplicate pay for which a small sum was charged 201. In that time there were 21 new borrowers of whom 13 were juvenile. New books were received 8 by gift and 2 by purchase, showing an estimated list today of 6,322. It is planned to take stock during the coming summer and check up on the figures which will undoubtedly prove to be less than those published.

A number of matters of routine were discussed by the board, there being present James Black, chairman; George Wilkinson, V. Basco-Bert, H. F. Pullen, George Sutherland and the librarian.

The fire department was called out at 5:30 yesterday afternoon to extinguish a grass fire near the corner of Second Avenue and Third Street. There was no damage.

A. D. Watt, divisional master of the Canadian National Railways, arrived in the city from Prince George on yesterday afternoon's train, returning to the interior this morning.

James A. Brown, well known Ecostall River mill operator, arrived in the city from the Skeena River on yesterday afternoon's train. Mr. Brown is still using crutches, having far from recovered from the effects of an accident last year when he was injured in an explosion aboard his motorboat.

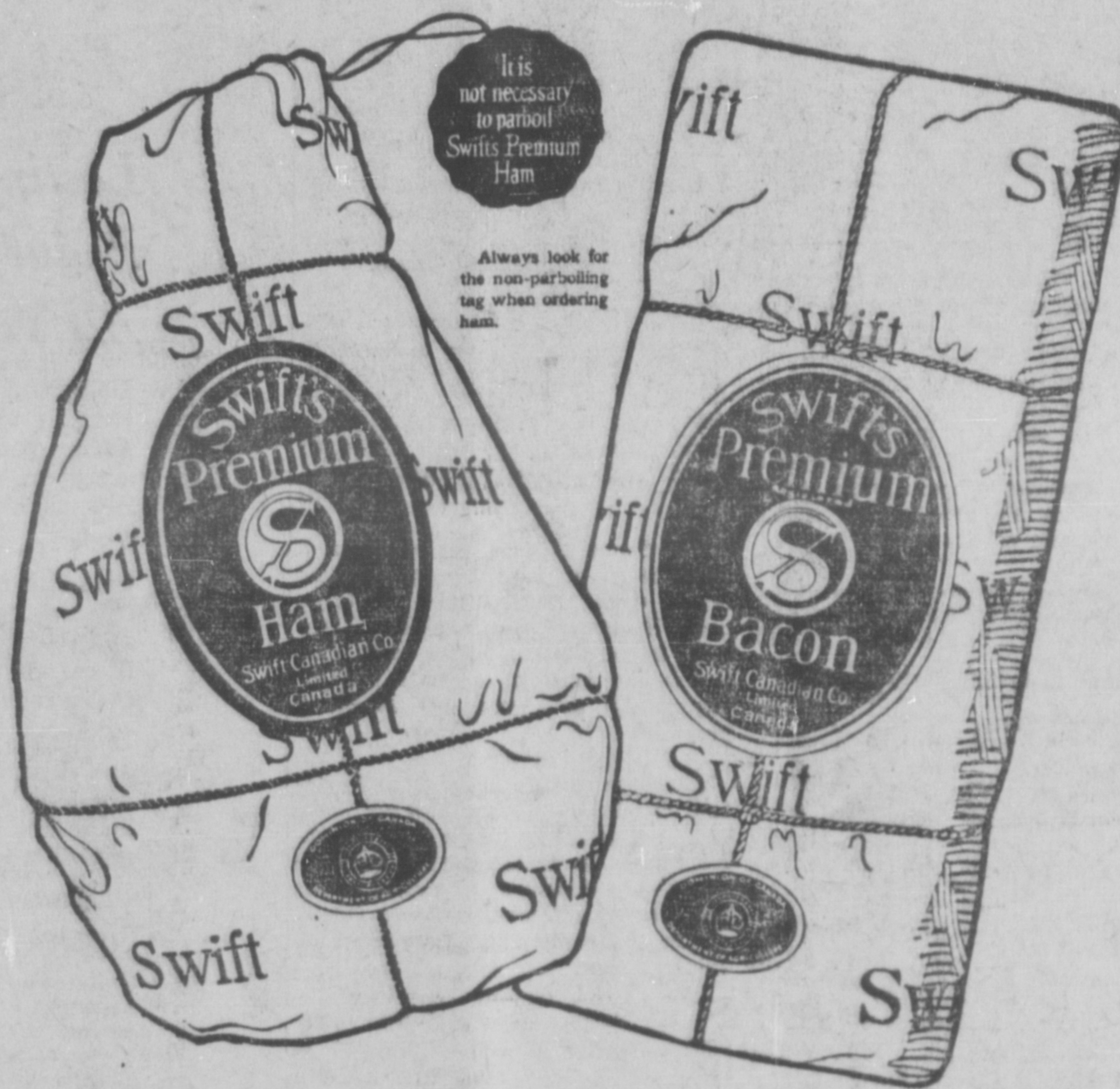
