AROUND PRINCE RUPERT

Vancouver Syndicates Take Over Claims on Tahtsa River; High-Grade Found On Homeguard; Bitter Creek Property Looking Good

C. L. Copp of Vancouver, acting on behalf of a syndicate of strong financial mining men, has taken over the Swannell group on the Tahtsa River in the Burns Lake district. Cabins have been erected and a good trail cut into the property. As soon as the snow goes in spring, considerable money will be spent on development work. Mr. Copp has recommended the property and believes that the very high-grade ore will warrant the expense of transportation over the long trail to the railway at Burns Lake. Mr. Copp is a pioneer British Columbia man and carries considerable weight with local and foreign financiers.

Spectacular specimens of high grade ore have been brought down to Alice Arm from the Homeguard property around which a company is being formed by Alice Arm men. The ledge has now been traced for a distance of over sixty feet by stripping on the surface and underground work is being pushed as rapidly as possible.

Preliminary development in progress since September by the Bitter Creek Mines Co. on their property on the south fork of Bitter Creek has consisted so far

of surface exploration and open cutting and has shown considerable length and width to the ore bodies already located. Two new veins have also been located carrying high values in silver. Samples chipped from the surface have given a return of 280 ounces of silver with a small gold content. Owing to the elevation of the vein and the lateness of the season, there has been no opportunity of doing any work on it this season. The other vein, striking diagonally across the formation, has also been traced 1000 to 1200 feet. Samples taken from this vein gave returns from 110 to 770 ounces of silver and from 27 percent to 60 percent lead. A short adit tunnel has been started on this vein. The management of the company is well satisfied with the outlook.

## PATTULLO AND THE GOVERNMENT

Member for Prince Rupert Tells North Vancouver His Opinion of Tolmie Administration

In an address at North Vancouver T. D. Pattullo member for Prince Rupert is reported to have said: "The present Provincial Government has already slashed and rough graded the road to its defeat by the policy it has adopted during the short time it has been in office. The Liberal opposition will follow the actions of the government with the utmost scrutiny and keep close check on its administration in the interests of the general public."

"Some people are of the opinion that because the Liberal party went down to defeat at the last provincial election it should remain inactive for some time," continued Mr. Pattullo. He urged the local Liberal Association to work all the harder to prepare the field for the next election. "British Columbia is not inherently Conservative in its political leanings," he added. "There is a large body of independent thought in this province. It therefore behooves the Liberal party to keep all its organization alive. Men of character should be interested, who would give their best in the interest of the province. The general public should be shown that we have men of ability in the party."
