

COMIC OPERA OVER RADIO

Tonight From 8 to 8:30 "The Red Hussar" Will Be on the Air

Edward Solomon's tuneful comic opera, "The Red Hussar," is scheduled to be presented in tabloid form during the weekly Eveready program tonight from 8 to 8:30 o'clock, broadcast through stations associated with the NBC system.

The principal roles in the Solomon work will be sung by Ethel Wakefield, soprano, Eva Gruinger Atkinson, contralto, Gwynfi Jones, tenor, and James Isherwood, baritone. Max Dolin will conduct the orchestra.

Queen Anne is ruler of England at the time the action of "The Red Hussar" takes place. England and France are at war. Ralph Rodney, once a wealthy gentleman, joins the regiment of Corporal Bundy and goes to the English camp near Bruges, Flanders. He loves a young girl, Kitty Carroll, who follows the army to the continent.

Rodney disguises himself as a German girl and secretly leaves the camp to meet Kitty. Sir Henry Leighton, the commanding officer, discovers Rodney's absence and immediately condemns him. Barbara, a maiden whom Sir Leighton loves, but who, in turn, loves Rodney, purchases the latter's discharge. A happy climax brings the comic opera to its conclusion.

The Novelty Trio contributes "Sweet Little Old Lady" and "Climbin' Up the Golden Stairs" in unusual vocal harmonies. The irrepressible Shenanigan Duo sings "When Polly Walks Through the Hollyhocks."
