Ten Years Ago in Prince Rupert

November 17, 1918

Salmon and halibut fishermen operating out of this port are getting together in order to impress upon the government the necessity for further float accommodation at Prince Rupert for the fishing fleet.

The death occurred today in the Prince Rupert General Hospital of Louis Cleveland Knauss, aged 35, one of the best known miners and prospectors of the interior district.

Today's train from the East is more than twenty-four hours late because of a slide at Tete Jaune as a result of which three workmen were killed.

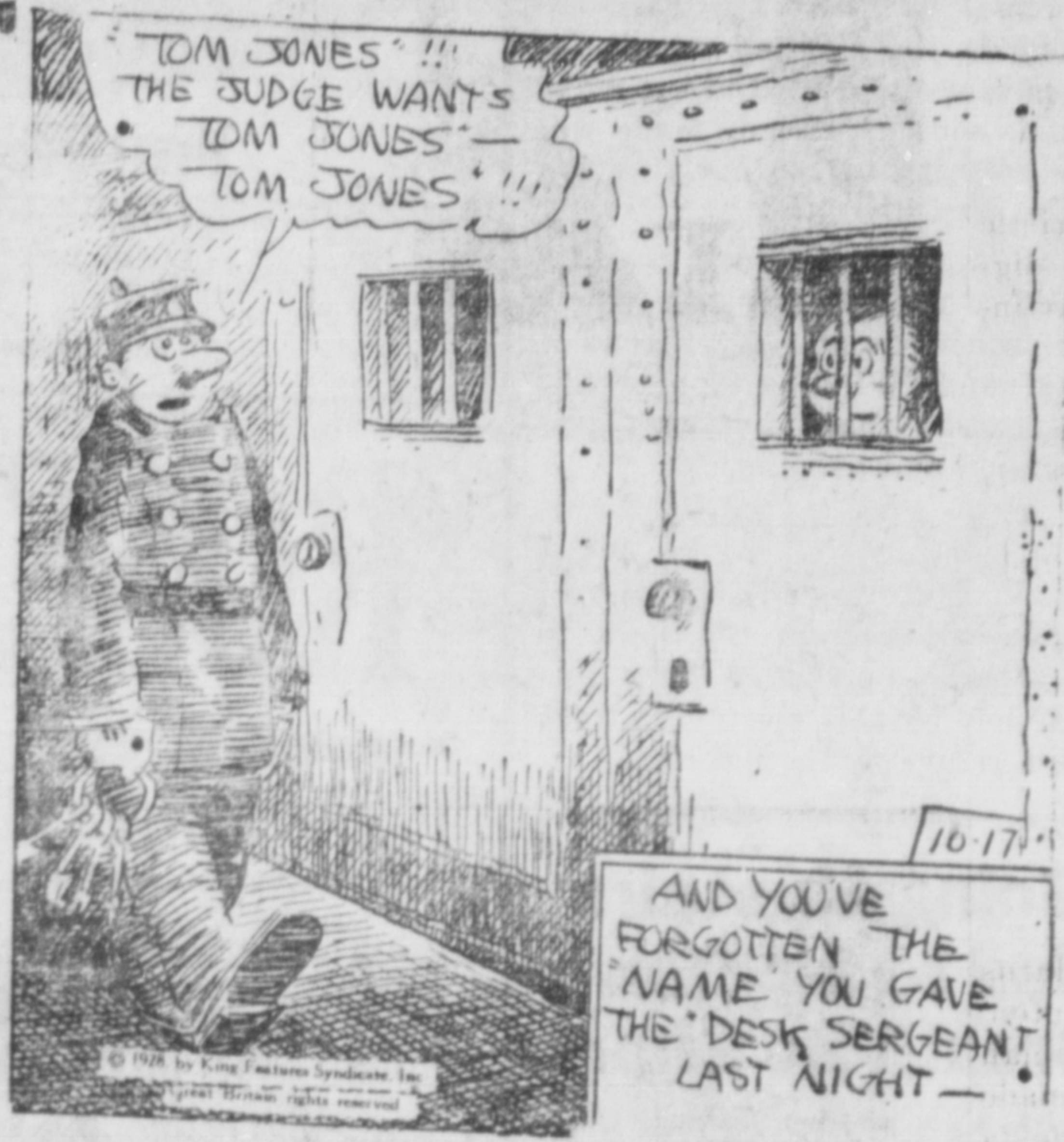
