Ten Years Ago in Prince Rupert

October 27, 1918 The Canadian Pacific steamer Princess Sophia, Capt. F. L. Locke, founded from Vanderbilt Reef in Lynn Canal where she struck a couple of days ago. The ship was at first believed to be in a safe position but a storm came up and she broke in two and fell off the rock. Two hundred and seventy five passengers and the crew of 75 were all lost. There were seventeen passengers for Prince Rupert. (Capt. Locke was the father of Mrs. B. J. Melish of Prince Rupert.

The paper mill at Swanson Bay has been working steadily throughout the influenza epidemic. Provincial Constable George Logan, who returned to the city from there yesterday, reports. There have been no deaths among the whites there.
