**ATHLETIC HOPE IS GIVEN BOOST**

MACKMEN WON TWO GAMES FROM WHITE SOX YESTERDAY WHILE YANKS DROPPED TWO TO TIGERS

NEW YORK, July 26—There were belated pennant hopes in the hearts of the Philadelphia Athletics yesterday as they won two games of a double-header over the Chicago White Sox while the New York Rangers dropped two games to the Detroit Tigers. This leaves the Mackmen but nine-and-a-half games behind the leaders and, consequently, there is great enthusiasm in the Philadelphia camp. Perchance this should be the start of a long losing streak for the Yanks, the Athletics would yet have a chance although it would be such a sensation as Big League baseball has not seen for many a long year. Cleveland Indians, by winning both games from the Boston Red Sox, went back into sixth place over the Washington Senators who dropped two games to the St. Louis Browns.

The race lightened up in the National League when St. Louis Cardinals and Chicago Cubs were beaten by Brooklyn and Boston respectively while New York Giants won a tight game from the Pittsburgh Pirates and Cincinnati Reds and the Phillies broke even on a double-header. But six-and-a-half games now separate the leading Cards from the fourth place Giants with the Cubs and Reds between.

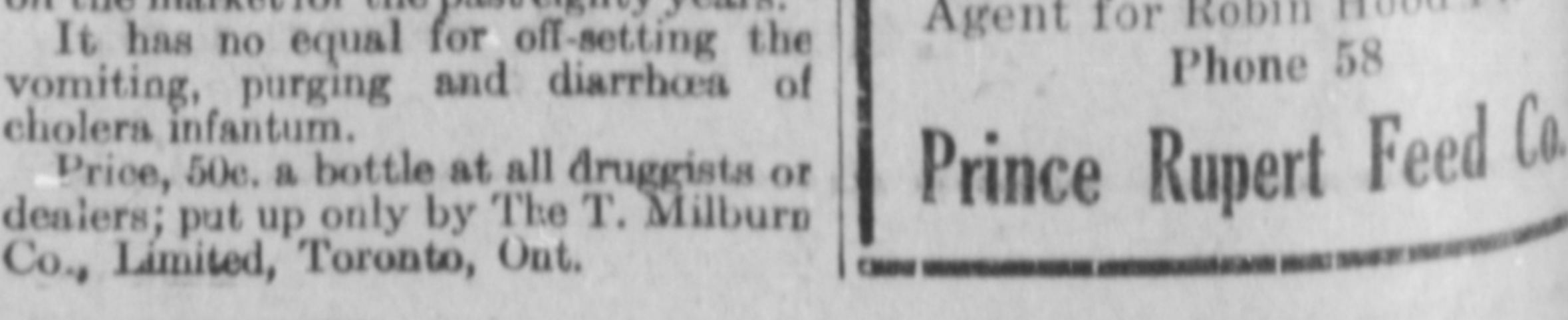
