Notwithstanding any of the provisions of this or any other bylaw of the city shall be unlawful for any person in charge, control or in possession of any vehicle .horse, or other animal to allow or permit such vehicle, horse, or other animal to stand or remain stationary in front of any theatre, or building used for the purpose of public entertainment. theatre entrance or exit, or fuel intake, fire-hall, or hotel entrance, so as to obstruct the free and unir arrupted access, ingress and egress to and from such theatre, building, theatre entrance or exit, fuel intake, fire hall, and such other places as may be designated by proper signs erected by the chief of police.
