SYNOPSIS OF LAND ACT AMENDMENTS

PRE-EMPTIONS Vacant, unreserved, surveyed Crown lands may be pre-empted by British subjects...

PURCHASE Applications are received for purchase of vacant and unreserved Crown lands, not being timberland, for agricultural purposes...

HOMESITE LEASES Unsurveyed areas, not exceeding 20 acres, may be leased as homesites, conditional upon a dwelling being erected in the first year...

LEASES For grazing and industrial purposes areas not exceeding 640 acres may be leased by one person or a company.

GRAZING Under the Grazing Act the Province is divided into grazing districts and the ranges administered under a Grazing Commissioner.
