

COURT AGREED CURRIE APPEAL

Did Not Hear Counsel for Defence in Case Involving Commanding Officer

In dismissing the appeal of F. W. Wilson and W. T. R. Preston from the verdict of the jury awarding Sir Arthur Currie \$500 damages for libel, the court did not call on counsel for Sir Arthur. Chief Justice Latchford said members of the court were all agreed that nothing had taken place to lead them to grant a new trial. The only error, he said, was that of the trial judge who had allowed too much latitude to counsel for the defendants.

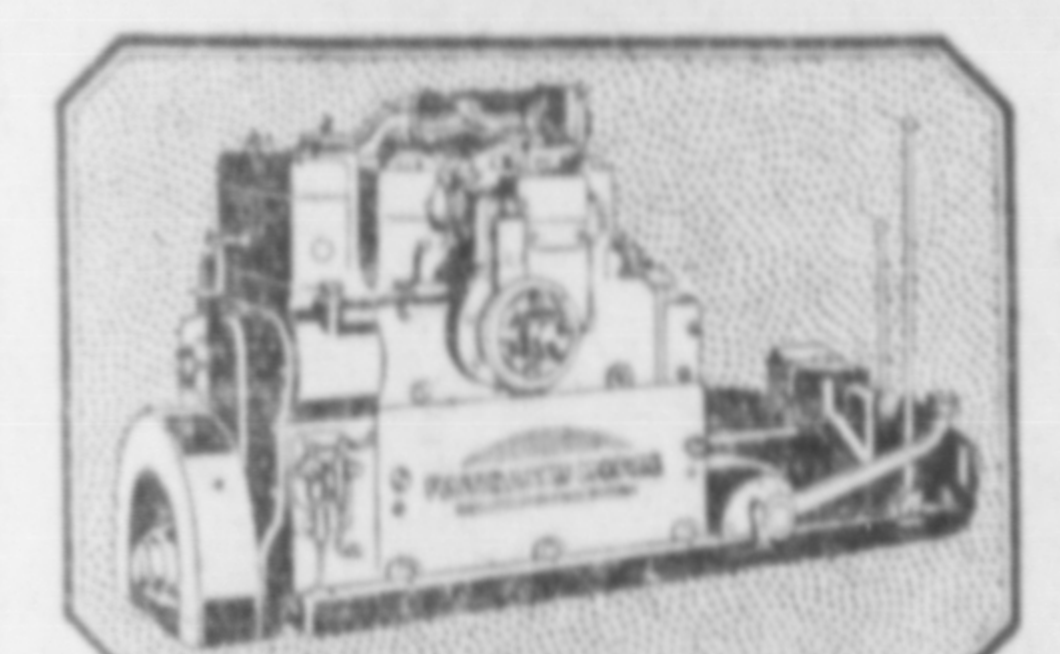
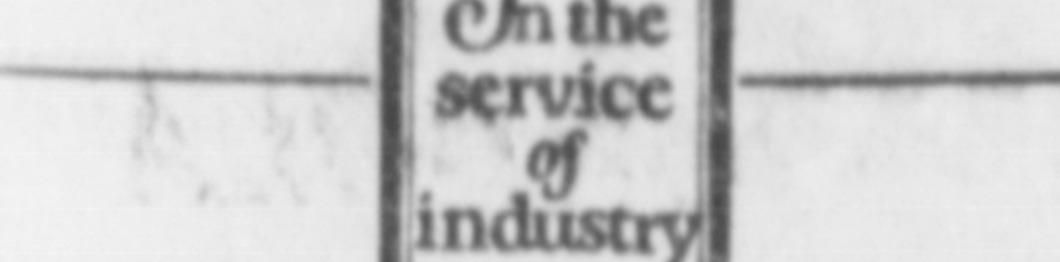
