

LONDON, April 23.—In London now there are nearly as many folks carrying their wares in the gutter and plying their trades in the street, as there were in the days of good Queen Bess; you can hardly walk abroad without seeing such quaint, gay, colorful sights and busy craftsmanship as might belong to the oldtime when half the town's business was done in the streets," says a writer in the Daily News and Westminster Gazette.

"Here is a man with magic flowers unfolding in a glass of water, here a vendor of joss-sticks with a sample smouldering on his tray; there is a nimble fellow with toys that run and jump as nimbly as himself, and there is a man with a pair of tame jackdaws which will perch on your hand for a penny. There is an old man who peddles rock-salt in a child's pram, and a young one who sells country flowers in suburban side streets from an old Ford. If your fancy is for a live lobster, a tortoise or a puppy dog, bitter oranges or branches of eucalyptus silver topped walking sticks or sham dolls that squeak, you will find them all at the curbstone market.

For entertainment you have as much as any citizen of Elizabethan London: the ballad singers, the clowns and the tumblers, still contrive to please the crowd as their forefathers did—though now it is ranged two by two outside the theatre. The street poet still flourishes, chalking his verses on the paving stones of the Embankment, and the basket maker sets out his gaudy wares in Kingsway, making his strip of pavement look like the corner of an Indian bazaar; there is a one-armed

girl, who sits on a camp stool, painting pictures, and a sailor who squats cross-legged on the pavement working big ones, very fast, on canvas, with bright colored wools, and knife-grinders and many another besides.

"Despite all the wide streets and brand new concrete of our modern London, her citizens still take their way among workers and chaffers, just as they did when the sweep shouted his trade from the house tops, and 'Cherry-ripe' was cried in the streets."
