News of the Mines

AROUND PRINCE RUPERT

Immense New Ore Body Opened up at Duthie Mine—Consolidated Pleased with Emerald Property in Sibola—Cronin Mine in New Deal.

With the uncovering of one of the richest bodies of ore ever encountered at the Duthie mine, it has been established that ore was far from cut off by the Thompson fault as some seemed to fear. J. R. Turner, superintendent, however, did not maintain this view and continued work in the McPherson tunnel beyond the perplexing intrusion with the result that a very strong ore body was opened up from which shipments are now being made. The tunnel, advanced 230 feet, is still in ore without a break, backs amounting to 650 feet. This ore is being stoped out and there are indications that here may be opened up the largest ore body on the Duthie property. Work has been proceeding at a good rate in the further extension of the mill tunnel which now has a total length of approximately 1600 feet. In this tunnel the same important ore body as was encountered in the McPherson tunnel has also been broken into. An examination of some of the new ore from the lower tunnel shows solid rub sylver and the ore throughout is very high grade. As a result of these recent finds, there should be a tremendous new tonnage of mill feed worth hundreds of thousands of dollars and fully justifying expenditures planned to double the capacity of the mill. Duthie is now operating with a net profit of \$20,000 per month. With the new ore and the increasing of the capacity of the mill, the mine should soon be earning two or three times that amount. It is suggested that a wealthy private syndicate at present operating some of the richest mines in Northern Ontario, may take over the Duthie mine. Its representatives are reported to have been on the ground recently.

During the past summer eight men have been employed by the Consolidated Mining and Smelting Co., under the superintendency of H. C. Hughes, in development of the Emerald group of mineral claims on Sweeney Mountain in the Sibola district. The work has consisted of extending tunnels run under an option held formerly by the late James Cronin. One tunnel was carried forward for close to 200 feet and another tunnel started was run about sixty feet when the work closed. The ore has been very pleasing. Work on the property, it is expected, may be continued for a few weeks yet. Consolidated is also continuing operations on the Harvey group in the Babine where good progress is being made in driving a tunnel to tap ore on which the owners have worked for some time.

Several important strikes of ore have featured recent operations at the Topley-Richfield mine. Outstanding in the new discoveries was a strong shoot of ore picked up in driving the tunnel from the west vein to the east vein. This ore returned \$70 in gold in addition to over \$40 in silver. In the south drift some very fine ore has been disclosed and the mine is reported to be improving with every shift. Diamond drills are now being moved to the underground workings of the property where they will be employed until spring. There is much activity now in transporting winter supplies to the mine. Twelve feet a day has been the average program of tunnelling.

mine, acquired recently by Grant Mahood for the Alexandria Gold Mines Ltd., of Toronto, has been in turn taken over by a wealthy English corporation for development according to announcement made a few days ago by Mr. Mahood. The name of the new company is the Anglo-London Mining Corporation. Development and full operation of the property will be proceeded with as soon as conditions permit of heavy machinery being taken over the road to the mine. Mr. Mahood stated that he had transferred his entire interest in the option to the new corporation. No change in present plans for development or officials is anticipated.

Cazaro Vavanzio whose staking of a big copper showing in the Ktimaat district was recently reported, has just made a further examination of the big ledge which he now says is 90 feet wide instead of 45, the galena ledge being 16 feet in width. Vavanzio, who says the copper was known to him years ago, is confident that the discoveries are so favorably located that they will attract the attention of a big concern. It is hardly a small operator's proposition.

GRAND OLD MAN JAP INLET HONORED

Birthday Party Held at Porcher Island Settlement to Mark A. E. Allen's 82nd Anniversary

JAP INLET, Nov. 8.—A very pleasant party was held here recently at the home of James Wanhope to honor the eighty-second birthday of A. E. Allen, former resident of Jap Inlet but now living at Kamloops where he works every day and is enjoying excellent health. The party was well attended, even guests from Prince Rupert being present.

A splendid banquet was served. John Murray gave the time-honored health toast, coupling it with Mr. Allen's name. James Wanhope responded. For the benefit of some guests who were newcomers, a brief outline was given of Mr. Allen's activities since he came to Porcher Island. Formerly a United States lawyer, having been district attorney for the state of Wyoming, and at one time an employee of the Canadian Fish & Cold Storage Co. at Prince Rupert, Mr. Allen was the first man to attract attention to the mining possibilities of Porcher Island and was the discoverer of several important leads, some of which are now in process of development. For several years he took prizes at the Prince Rupert Exhibition for his mineral exhibits especially lime rock. Mr. Wanhope concluded his remarks by wishing Mr. Allen many happy returns of the day.
