AMERICANS SURPRISED WHEN CHAUFFEUR WHO HELPED THEM RECEIVES BOWS OF COLONY TRYSIDE SOFIA, Oct. — Two professors at the American college at Samokov, 30 miles from here, were returning from the earthquake zone by auto when their engine broke down 20 miles from Sofia. They spent three hours in vain attempts to make repairs, while daylight rapidly faded. They had reconciled themselves to sleeping in the fields over night, when another auto approached. "Can I help you?" the chauffeur of the second car said in Bulgarian as he drew up beside the stranded Americans. "Yes, but we are afraid you cannot do much. We have worked with the engine for three hours without much success." Throwing aside his coat, the friendly young chauffeur, whom the Americans noticed had a strikingly studious and refined face proceeded to raise the hood covering the engine and to examine the carburetor, magneto and spark plug. Within ten minutes he had put his finger on the seat of the trouble. "Try it now," he said, his face and hands besmeared with grease. One of the Americans put his foot to the starter and the car started. Suddenly one of the professors remembered that "we did not give that poor fellow a cent for his trouble." Ten minutes later the second car came up with them and the Americans were amazed to see the whole countryside saluting and bowing homage to the young man who had extricated them. They were stupefied later when they found that he was King Boris of Bulgaria.

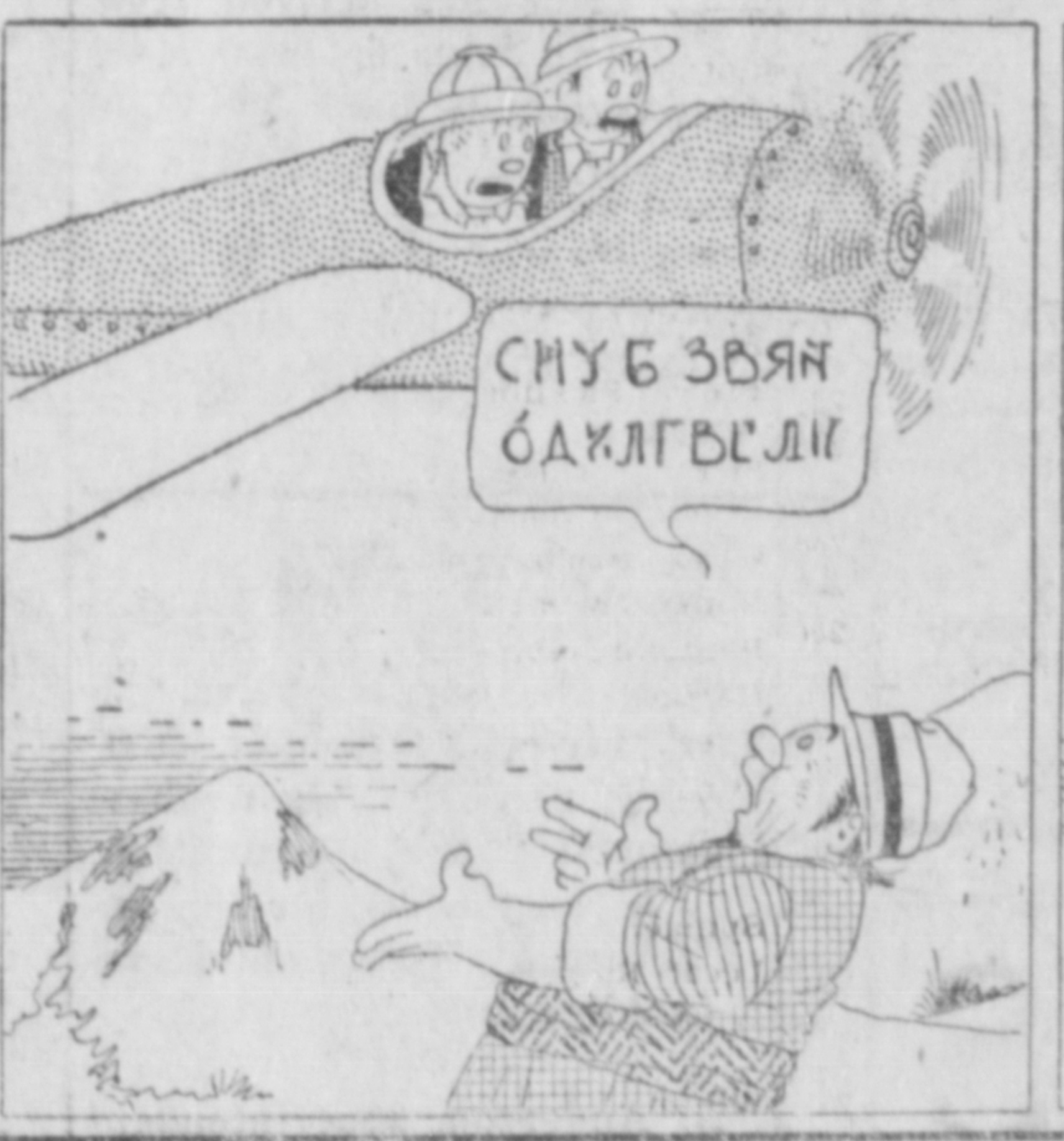
