The sockeye pack in District No. 2 this year totals 177,000 cases as against 113,000 cases last year. Salmon fishing closed throughout the district last night except on Queen Charlotte Islands.

A special train carrying His Excellency the Duke of Devonshire, Governor-General of Canada, and party will arrive in Prince Rupert at 8:30 tomorrow evening.

Small number of halibut boats arriving indicates the approach of stormy winter weather. One by one the smaller boats are now tying up until next spring.

CHILE IS FIRST OF LATIN-AMERICANS GIVE WOMEN VOTE

SANTIAGO, Chile, Sept. 25.—With the passage of the new code of internal administration, now before the Chilean congress, Chile will be the first Latin-American country to adopt women suffrage on an extensive scale, as this code gives women and foreigners the right to vote in municipal elections. So far, only one state in Brazil and one province in Argentina have given even a limited voting privilege to women. Granting foreigners a right to vote in municipal elections is also a decided innovation, and indicative of the democratic spirit pervading Chile.
