## Ten Years Ago

A vote of all union men in the city was taken today and it was decided by a margin of 345 to 170 to go out on sympathy strike. The date when the strike will commence is to be decided by the Trades & Labor Council.

Orme occupied the chair and the presentation of a fine gold watch was made to the guest of honor by Art Noble. Mr. Young replied suitably. Canon G. A. Rix and Theo Collart were also speakers.
