Ten Years Ago in Prince Rupert

March 12, 1919

Between 500 and 600 men will be employed at the local dry dock in the building of two ocean going ships for the Canadian government, states J. L. Mullen of Pittsburg, president of the Prince Rupert Dry Dock & Engineering Co., who is in the city in connection with the commencement of operations. The material will soon start arriving here.

Lieut. Col. C. W. Peck V. C., M. P. for Prince Rupert, will defend Lieut. General Currie in the House of Commons against Sir Sam Hughes' sensational charges that there were unnecessary losses among Canadian troops at Cambrai and Mons at the conclusion of the Great War.

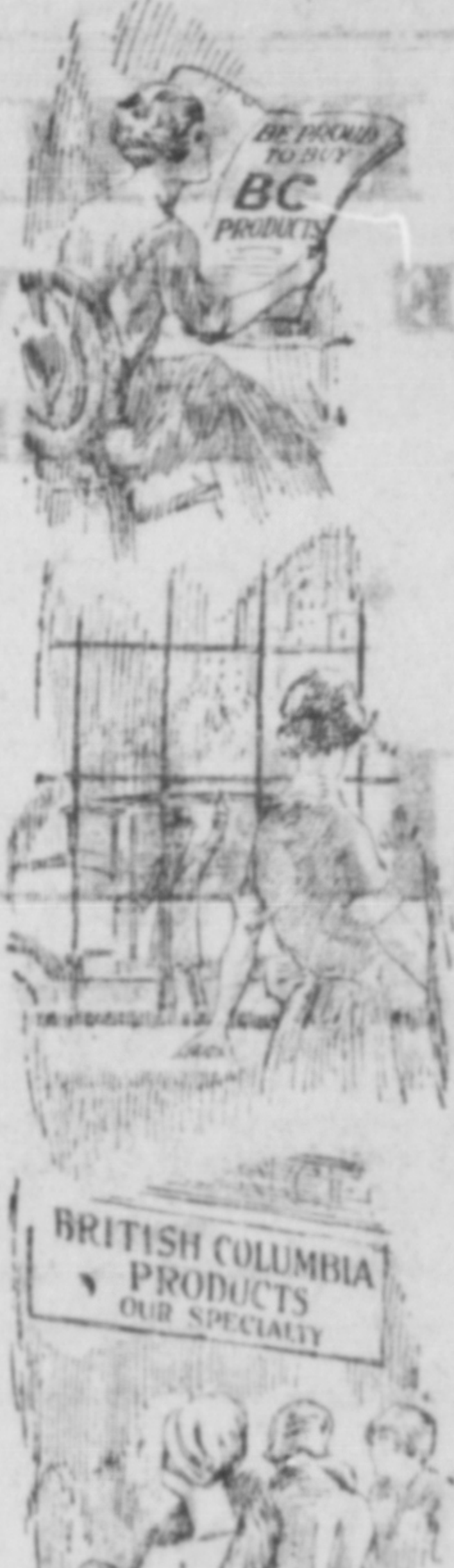
