Correspondence from J.W. Gibson, supervisor of technical education for the province, was read at last night's school board meeting in the matter of High School correspondence courses which at least two local young men are desirous of taking up. These courses are given without charge, it was pointed out.

School trustees at the meeting last night discussed the practice of transporting pupils in Westview to and from Borden Street School. It was felt by one trustee that the Westview School had been established so this would not have to be done while another was of the belief that parents should be responsible for their children getting to and from school. This should be considered when people established residence in that part of the city. However, since the practice had been started, it was felt that it could hardly be discontinued for the time being at least.
