aND WHELEAS the whole debt of the City of Prince Rupers, not including for Local Improvement and School purposes. Nine nunared and Six Thousand Three Hundred Ninety-nine Dollars and 'Ihirty-six Cents, which is not twenty per centum of said assessed amount. NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PRINCE RUPERT ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. It shall be lawful for the City of Prince Rupert to complete the said sewer in the City of Prince Rupert according to the plans and specifications prepared by the City Engineer, and approved by the Municipal Council of the City of Prince Rupert, and deposited in the office of the City Engineer, such plans and specifications to be subject to alterations, amendments, or additions to be made before or during the construction of the work, such additions, alterations and amondmonts to be subject to the same approval as the original plans and specifications and to be deposited in the and manner in the Office of the City Engineer; the intent of this bylaw being that in completing such sewer the same shall be so completed as to best meet the actual requirements of the city. 2. For the purpose of paying for the completion of the sewer hereby author+ ized it shall be lawful for the said City. of Prince Rupert to create a debt to the amcunt of \$19,000.00, which debt shall be payable in twenty years from the 1st day of January, A.D., 1929, for which debt debencures may be issued to be secured as hereinaiter mentioned. 3. Debentures of the said Corporation to the amount of \$19,000.00 in the whole may be issued by the Mayor and reasurer of the City of Prince Rupert in terms of the "Municipal Act" in sums of not less than \$100.00 Each of said lebentures shall be signed by the Mayor Treasurer and shall be sealed with
