

NATIVE SONS RETAIN LEAD IN BASEBALL

Defeated Elks in Five Inning Game at Acropolis Hill Last Night

The Sons of Canada retained their hold on first place in the City Baseball League last night when they defeated the Elks in a five inning game, five to three. Vic Menzies started for the Sons and pitched effectively for three and one-third innings, holding the Elks to three hits. Downie relieved him in the fourth and, after making a wild pitch on the first ball he threw, which allowed Gosse to tie the score from third, held the Elks down for the remainder of the game. Loblick hurled for the Antlered crew and was nicked for nine safeties altogether.

The Elks scored one run in the first inning. Harold went out. Wendle to Mitchell. Arseneau hit one past second and then stole second and third. A. Mitchell hit to left and Arseneau scored. Loblick then hit into a double. Menzies to Downie to Mitchell. Their other two runs came in the fourth. Loblick was safe on Wendle's error. He stole second and was hit on the head by the throw. W. Mitchell dropped the throw from Smith on Gurvich's grounder and Loblick took third. Gosse hit past the pitcher and Loblick scored and Lambie's throw-in cut Gurvich off at the plate, Gosse taking third on the play. Downie then went into the box, and after wild pitching Doc home, struck out Stevens and Budnich.

The Native Sons started things rolling in the second. Smith and Menzies singled, Astoria fanned, but Phillips hit one at Stevens, which bounced back into the infield and filled the bags. Frizzell struck out. Mitchell then drove one into right field and Smith and Menzies crossed the plate. Phillips ended the inning trying to steal third. In the fourth Menzies was safe on Budnich's error after Smith had struck out. He went to second on Astoria's hit. He stole third as Phillips fanned, and scored on Frizzell's hit to right, Astoria being caught at the plate by Moore's throw-in. They got two more in the fifth. Mitchell hit to left. Lambie was safe when A. Mitchell threw his brother out at third. Wendle hit to left. Downie then smacked a line drive over Mitchell's head and Wendle and Lambie scored. Smith fanned and Menzies hit one to left which Arseneau grabbed to end the inning. The score follows:
