**AROUND PRINCE RUPERT**  
Ore Bodies Reported On Big Missouri; Premier to Take B. C. Silver and Sebakwe; Rainy Hollow Claims Change Hands

Probable bre in the Big Missouri mine in the Stewart district is now estimated at \$350,000,000. Estimates give a width of 350 feet and a length on the strike of 1900 feet with 550 feet of backs and, figuring 12 cubic feet to the ton, this gives 30,000,000 tons of ore estimated to run \$19 per ton. In the two high-grade fracture zones, figuring on the same basis and considering only the 500 feet opened, there are 1,000,000 tons of ore estimated variously at from \$40 to \$50 per ton. Under present plans it is proposed to drop down the hill to the south 1500 to 2000 feet, and, driving a parallel tunnel at 400 feet greater depth, thus gain an additional 400 feet of backs, or a total of 950 feet.

C. H. Sawie, editor of the *Ominea Herald* of New Hazelton, after having not been there for five months, recently paid another visit to the Silver Cup mine in his district and he was inclined to marvel at the transformation that had been brought about during that time in the construction of the mill that is now in operation and other noticeable changes. Mr. Sawie, in an article in his paper, fully describes the new operating property. His compliments the company owning the mine on its courage and foresight in bringing the property to its present stage.

It is predicted in Stewart that a deal will eventuate whereby Premier Gold Mining Co. will take over the adjoining B. C. Silver and Sebakwe properties. A deal with this purpose in view was under discussion some time ago between the respective contracting parties, but no agreement was reached at that time and negotiations were called off. Now, however, it is stated that negotiations have been resumed with prospects of a successful conclusion of the deal, which would mean the early production of both the B. C. Silver and Sebakwe mines through the use of the Premier's milling and tramway equipment. Both B. C. Silver and Sebakwe have been carrying on extensive development programs and now have large ore bodies blocked out. It is said that, if the pending deal goes through, the capital stock of the Premier Co. will be increased to take care of the outstanding shares of the B. C. Silver and Sebakwe properties. The Premier has expended to date on its property \$2,500,000 and has paid dividends of other \$13,000,000. The B. C. Silver has expended \$27,000 in exploration work and the Sebakwe \$2,000,000.

The Stampede group of gold in galena and chalcopyrite. A bearing claims, located in the Rainy Hollow district in the extreme northwestern corner of British Columbia, has been taken over by P. R. Bradley of the Gastineau Juneau Mining Co. of Juneau, the price being \$100,000 with a cash payment. This property has been owned by William Bunting of Hyder and John (Stampede) O. Stenbraten and was located five years ago. The ore is free milling gold, averaging about \$10 across four feet with values remarkably steady throughout. The vein has been traced for 2000 feet. A shaft has been sunk and other work done to open up the property. The new owner will spend \$20,000 this year and will bring the property to production as soon as possible.


ARCHBISHOP RECOVERING
