

The adit tunnel being driven to come under the main shaft on the property will also be continued to its objective with the object of opening a body of ore for early shipment. The tunnel is about 200 feet vertically below the outcropping and is said to have about 900 feet to go. Last year the Silver Crest Co. devoted its entire attention to developing the Saddle with a view to making a profitable high grade shipper of it. In addition to continuation of work on the Saddle, the company intends this season doing some diamond drilling on the original Silver Crest property which lies in close relation to the Big Missouri. P. E. Petersen, engineer for the company, has recommended probing below the capping that covers part of the Silver Crest group to determine whether or not the ore forming rock of Big Missouri really extends into Silver Crest ground. 
