Matthew Yoemans is chief native councillor at Massett this year and W. H. Russ is chief at Skidegate.

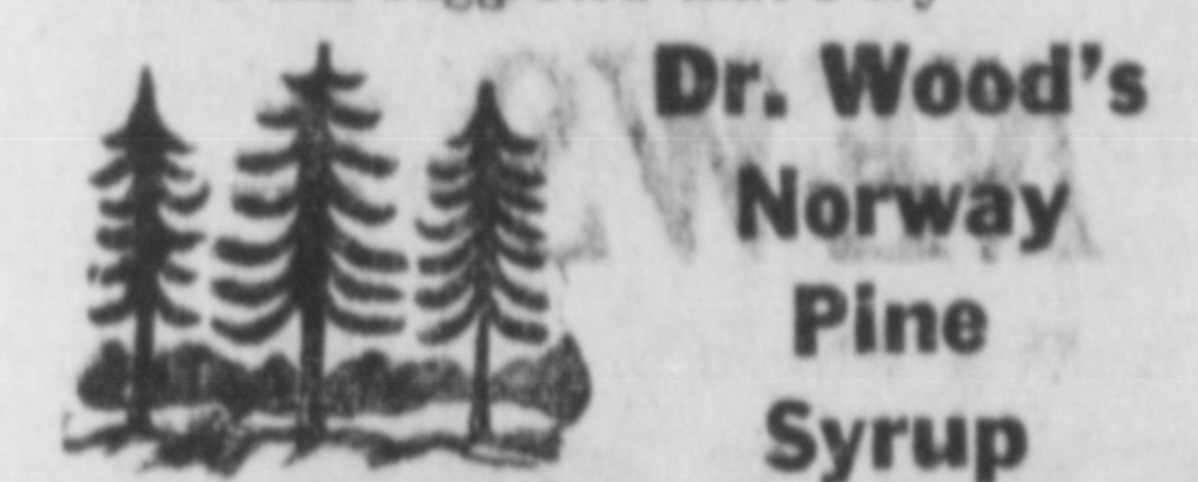
