POTATO PRICE IS HIGH HERE

Arrival of Fresh Seasonal Fruits and
 Vegetables Features Local
 Retail Price

The price of old potatoes on the
 local market has taken a decided ad-
 vance recently but there will be relief
 for the situation when the new crops
 begin to move in more freely. The first
 of the new crop potatoes are already
 here—California spuds retailing at 10c
 per pound and British Columbia at two
 pounds for 25c.

There has been a slight decrease in
 the price of sugar but a stiffening is
 expected with the coming season start-
 ing soon. Thrifty housewives would be
 well advised to lay in their sugar
 stocks at this time.

Asparagus from Terrace and other
 interior points has proven very popular
 on the local market this spring. The
 supply is about over.

Fine juicy Valencia oranges are now
 in to take the place of navels. Orange
 prices are advancing. There are also
 sharp advances in lemon prices.

With stocks of last year's crop near-
 ing exhaustion, apple prices are jump-
 ing. The new crop should soon be
 starting to come in.
